- 1. Meeting called to order by Jeremy Johnson at 9:07 AM.

- 6. *Update: Current Grants outlook/Financial:* Currently TIP has over \$67,000 in funds to use for the 2018 season. Currently we are in the process of finalizing an agreement with the town of Rolling in Langlade County to do \$2,500 worth of inventory and control work in their town. Mitch will be applying for additional funds through GLRI as well. Langlade County Forestry will not be able to set any money aside for TIP due to the purchase of Camp Lyle and improvements.
